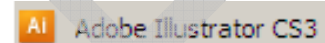

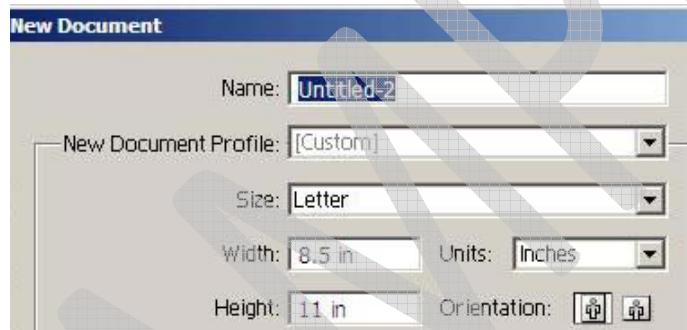

### Creating a Flower Shop Logo

1. START>PROGRAMS>Adobe Illustrator CS3.

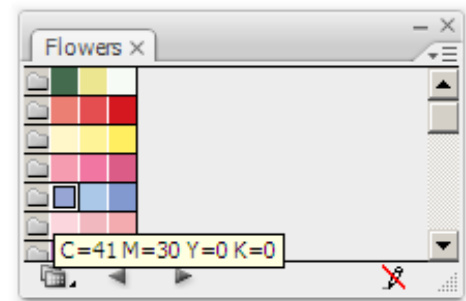


2. File>New and use these settings:

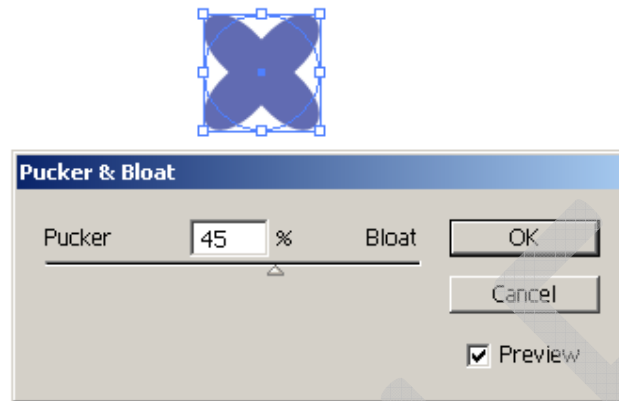


3. Go to Window>Swatch Libraries>Nature>Flowers.

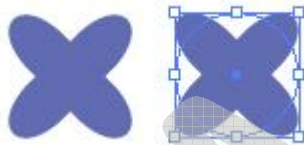
4. Select your Ellipse Tool. Hold SHIFT. Draw a circle as shown. Fill it with blue C=41 M=30 Y=0 K=0.



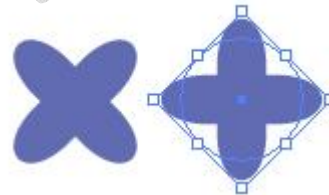
5. With the circle selected, go to **Effect>Distort & Transform>Pucker & Bloat** and use these settings:



6. Select the shape again. Hold **ALT** and drag a copy to the right with the **Black Arrow Selection Tool**.



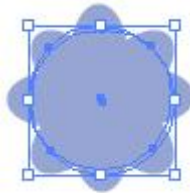
7. Rotate the shape as shown:



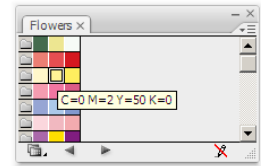
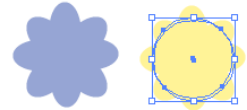
8. Place the rotated shape onto the original to make a flower.



9. Select both shapes by dragging around both with the **Black Arrow Selection Tool**. Go to **Object>Group** to group them together.



10. Make a copy of the flower, change the color to yellow (C=0 M=2 Y=50 K=0).



11. Make the yellow flower a little smaller and place it as shown:



12. Select your Ellipse Tool. Draw a small circle. Fill it with any color you want and place it as shown.




13. Select all three parts of the flower, hold ALT and make a copy. Change the inner circle to the color of your choice.



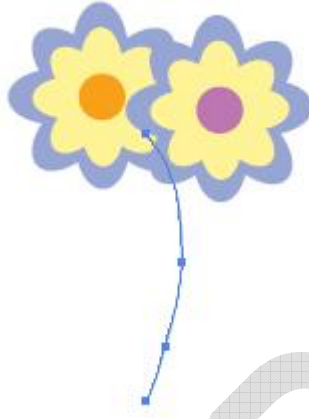
14. Select each flower separately and go to Object>Group. Then place them as shown. If necessary, to move the right flower in front of the left one, go to Object>Arrange>Bring to Front.



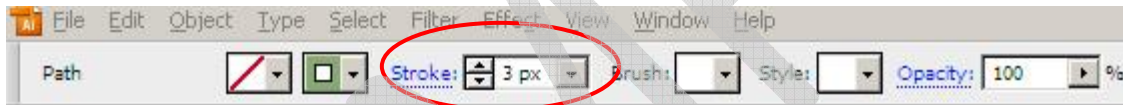
-  15. Select your Pencil Tool. Change your Stroke color to any green.



Draw a stem and keep it selected.



16. With the stem selected, change the Stroke weight to 3px.



17. Right-click the stem and choose Arrange>Send to Back to move the stem behind the flower. Then draw another stem as shown:



18. Select your Pencil Tool.  
Change your Fill color to any green.  
Draw a leaf shape.



19. Make a copy of the leaf and place them as shown:



**T** 20. Select your Type Tool. Click on your canvas. Type Flowers by [add your name], Inc.

21. Select the text with your mouse. On the Type Toolbar, change the font size as needed. Place the text as shown:
