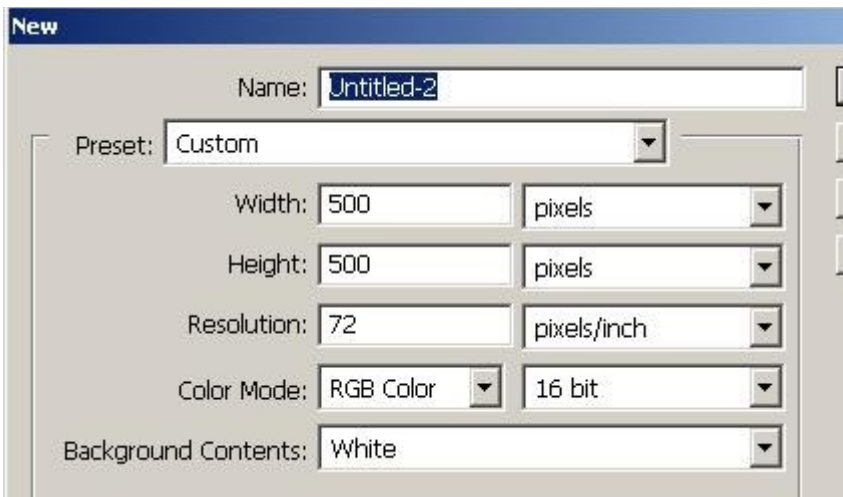
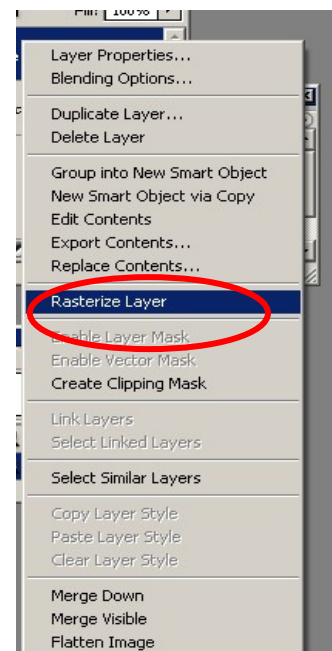
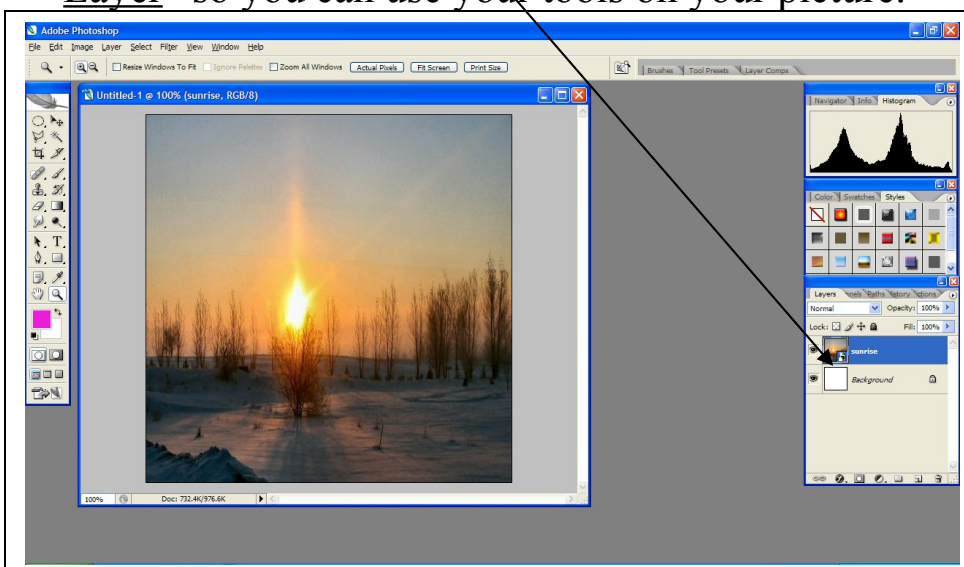


Lesson 3 – Wolves at Sunrise

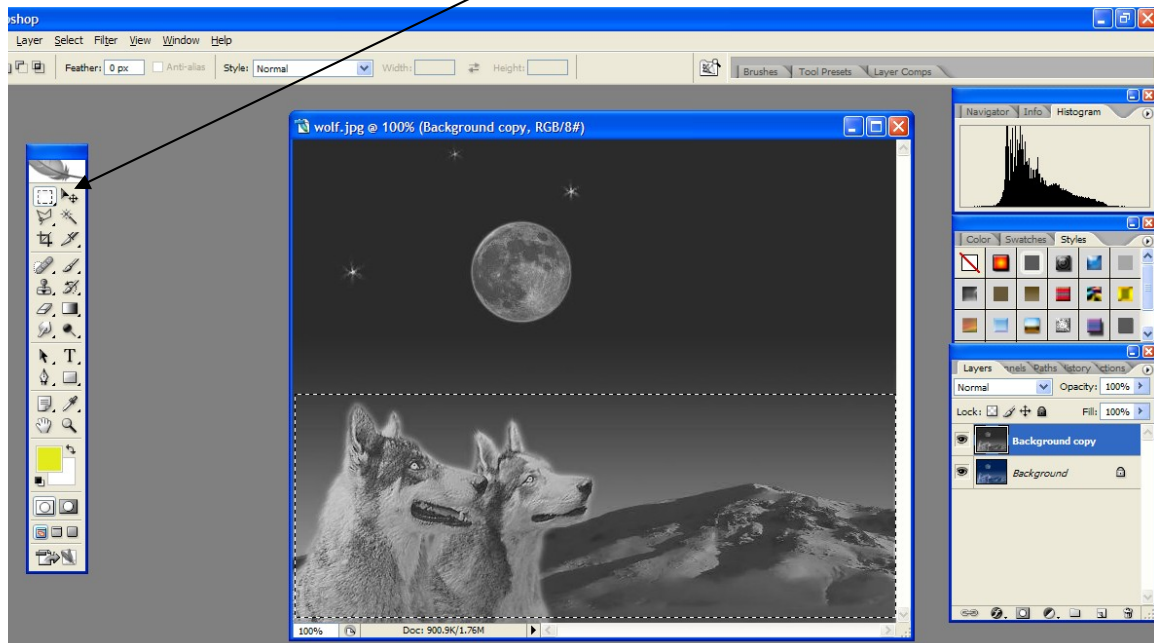
1. Go to START>PROGRAMS>Adobe Photoshop CS2, CS3 or CS4.
2. File>New and start a blank canvas like this:
(500x500pixels, 72 res., RGB, white)



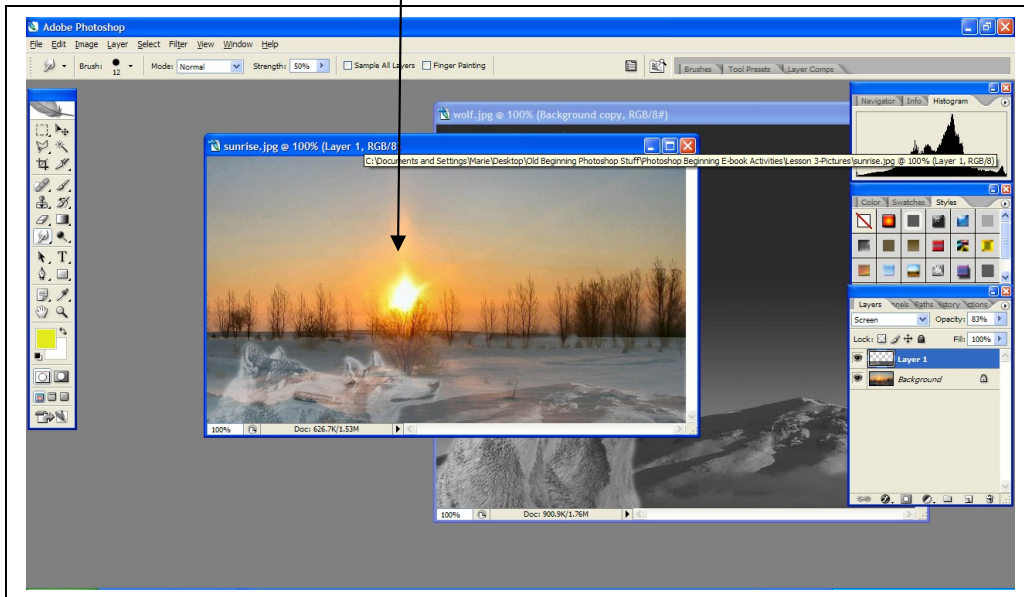
3. **File>Place** (NOT FILE>OPEN) and get the picture called “Sunrise” from the Lesson 3-Pictures. Stretch it over your canvas. Press ENTER.
4. Right click the Sunrise Layer and choose “Rasterize Layer” so you can use your tools on your picture.



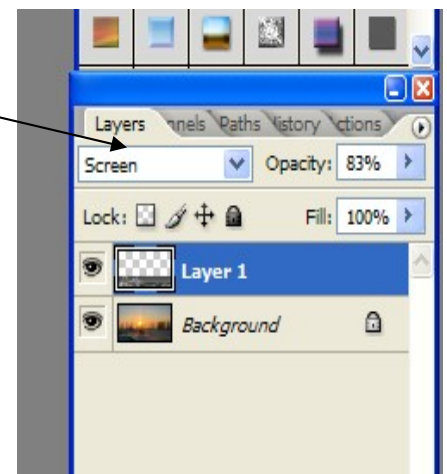
5. File>Open and Open and get the picture called “Wolf” from the Lesson 3 – Pictures folder. It will be Blue. Go to Layer>Duplicate Layer and Click OK. Go to Image>Adjustments>Desaturate. This will turn the picture black and white.
6. Click your Horizontal Rectangle Tool. Draw a rectangle around the wolves as shown below.

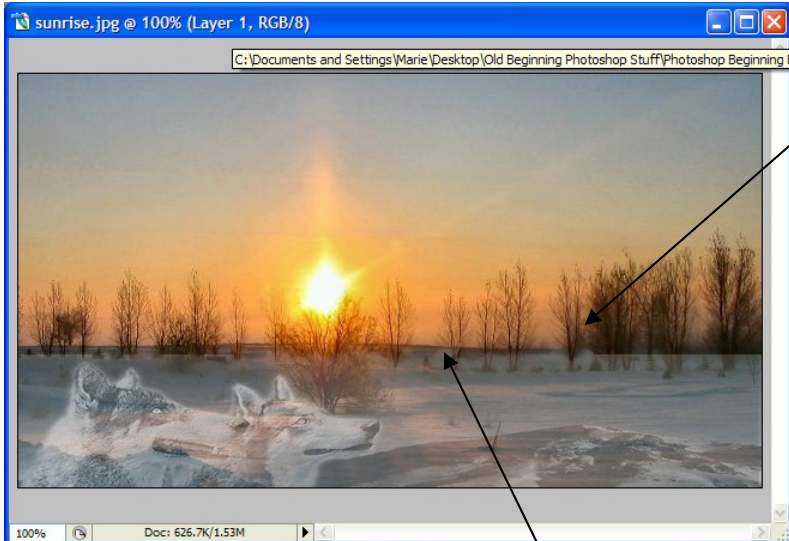


Click your Move tool and drag the wolves to the bottom of the sunrise picture. Do Ctrl T to resize the wolf picture until it fits at the bottom of the tree line. Press Enter.



7. Right click the “wolf layer” and choose “Rasterize Layer” if it is not grayed out.
8. Change the Blending Mode on the Wolf Layer to Screen and reduce the Opacity to 80%

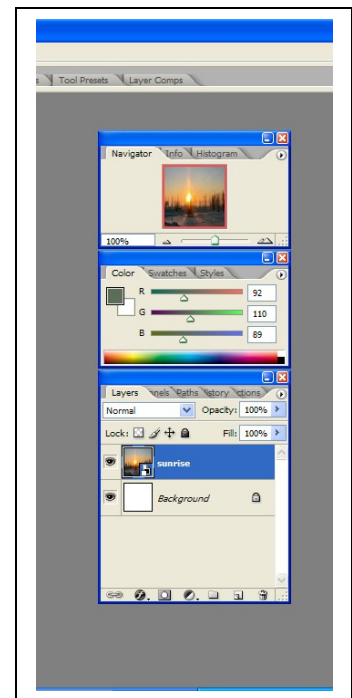
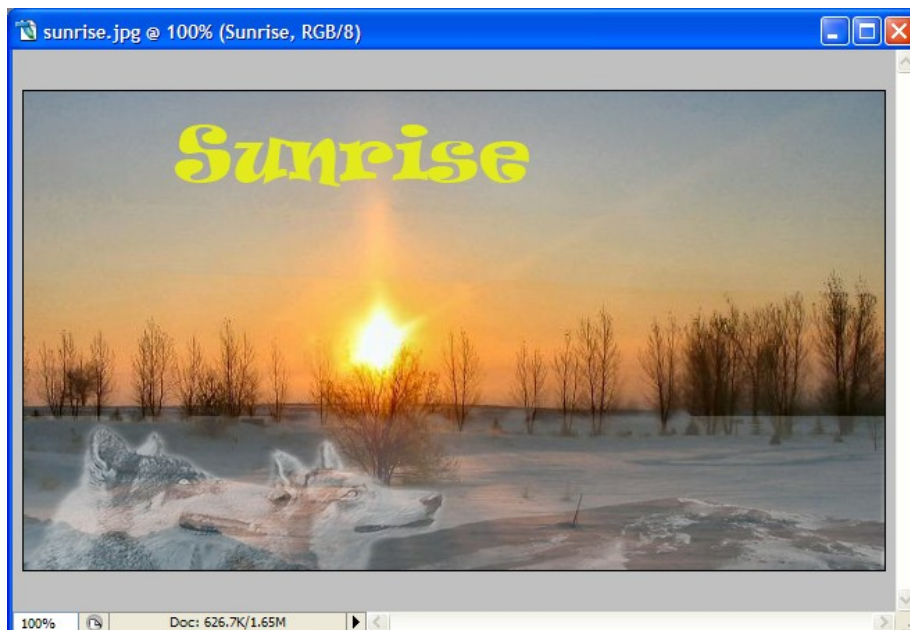
Select your “Smudge”
Tool. Hold down until
the “Smudge” Tool
Appears and click and
make it blurry.



Use your Smudge tool to smooth out the line between the sunrise and wolf pictures.

9. Select your Type Tool. Choose any color for your text.
Type the following: type Sunrise.

You can use any font you like



10. When done, go to Layer>Flatten Image (You can no longer make changes once you do this)
Save as: Wolves at sunrise.
